As students develop the physical skills on their instrument, their sheet music becomes more and more complex. It is imperative that they not only understand what they are playing but can intrinsically hear what they are playing. If students have a solid foundation in these skills, they are more likely to have a sense of ownership and develop musical independence; thus, will become well-rounded, confident musicians.

Our musicianship and rhythm class will allow students to develop a wide range of skills such as notation, understanding of form, creativity, memory and pattern recognition, ensemble skills, coordination, left/right brain skills, sight reading and independence. Our aim is to enable students to find their own voice, to develop an intrinsic sense of music as an art form and develop ownership of their learning that will inspire them to play more at home or at school with like minded musicians.
